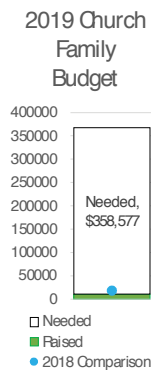

Guest Speakers: Rudy and Janet Salazar
Elder Rudy Salazar works for the Central California Conference in the Gift Planning and Stewardship Department. He grew up in Tijuana, Mexico. He came to the USA when he was 20 years old. Elder Salazar

received a Bachelor's Degree from Union College, and a Master's and Doctorate Degree from Andrews University. He met his wife Janet in Lincoln, Nebraska and they have two children, both studying in Michigan. **Janet Baden** was born in LaFayette, Indiana and grew up in Missouri. She has a Masters in Teaching from La Sierra University. Presently she is working for a non-profit organization that helps children with disabilities.

Sabbath School Seminar 9:45am-10:30am: Elder Rudy Salazar will be presenting a seminar on finances according to the Bible. *"Where does your wallet say your heart is?"* The Bible speaks a lot about money for a reason.
