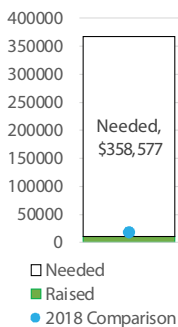

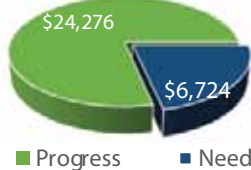

2019 Church Family Budget

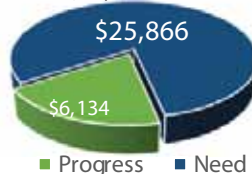
