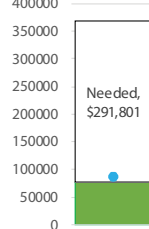

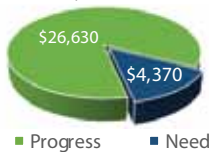

2019 Church Family Budget

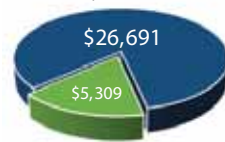


Tuition Assistance  
\$31,000 Goal



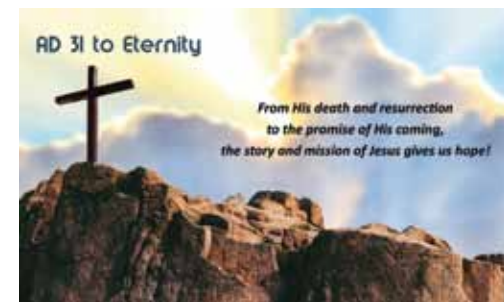
2018/2019 School Year


## **Book Share**
