- Two 61-gallon cardboard fiber barrels with lids (This item is very important!)
- Fourteen 2" x 4" x 8 foot lengths and two 10' long
- Six 1 x 4's 8 foot lengths
- Wood screws (3" & 4")
- Six sheets of 2-inch foam from a home improvement store
- One sheet 1" foam from a home improvement store
- 2 Large cardboard dryer boxes with cardboard protective corners, like from an appliance store.

They are seeking the following items to take with them by March 14. There is a collection box in the lobby. "Do for a few what you would like to do for many."

1. Chewable gummy children's vitamins and adult vitamins. (Costco Kirkland brand has best price.)
2. Soccer balls (deflated with a separate hand pump for each ball). 4-5+ balls will be given the village schools where each of the 5 clinics will be held.
3. Eyeglasses: Used prescription glasses and new/used reading glasses 1.25+, 1.5+ and 1.75+ are best strengths.
4. Matchbox type cars (given out at clinics).
5. Child and adult toothbrushes, small or medium toothpaste tubes and dental floss. Will be put into individual plastic bags.
6. Homemade paper whirligig toys with Bible verses. (ask Barb Holm for pattern)
7. Suitcases that can be left in Guatemala.

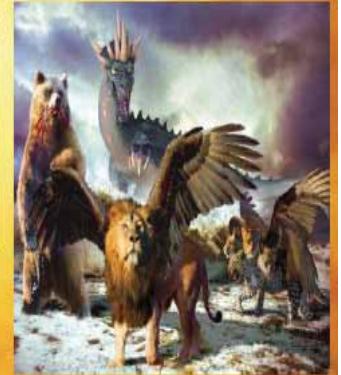
