Please wear your mask and maintain a safe social distance.

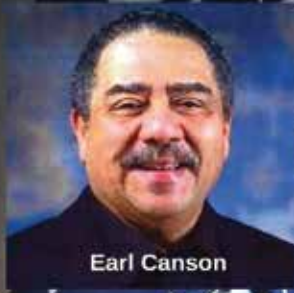

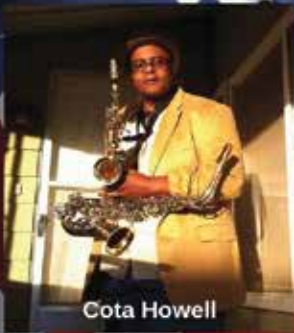
